Information about your EP visit

Your Electrophysiology appointment requires our physician's ample time to review your records prior to seeing you.

Electrophysiology appointments may sometimes take longer than other cardiology appointments due to the increase in medical record review, often complex medical history and discussions regarding electrophysiology related events.

Our priority is our patients and the care they receive; this sometimes requires our physicians taking more time, when needed, during your appointment. We understand that your time is valuable, and we work diligently to reduce wait time for all our patients. However, this is sometimes unavoidable.
